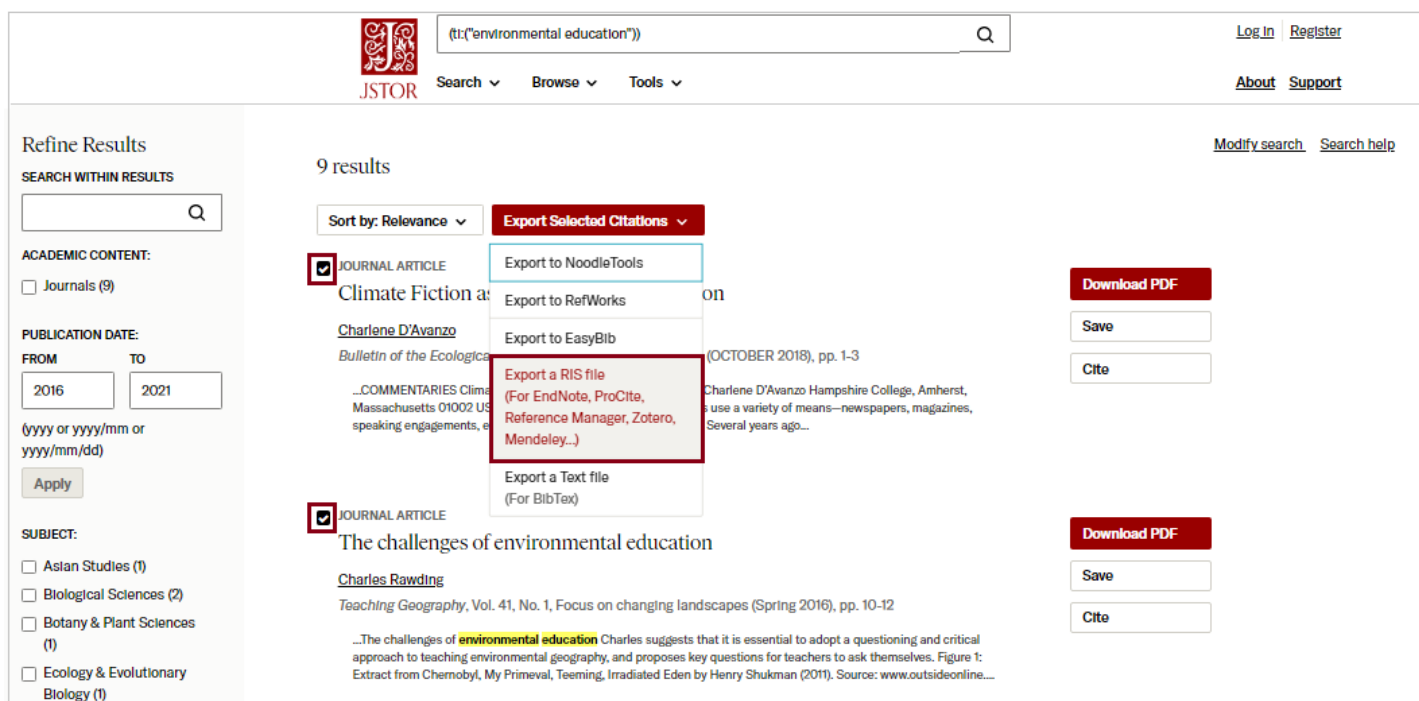


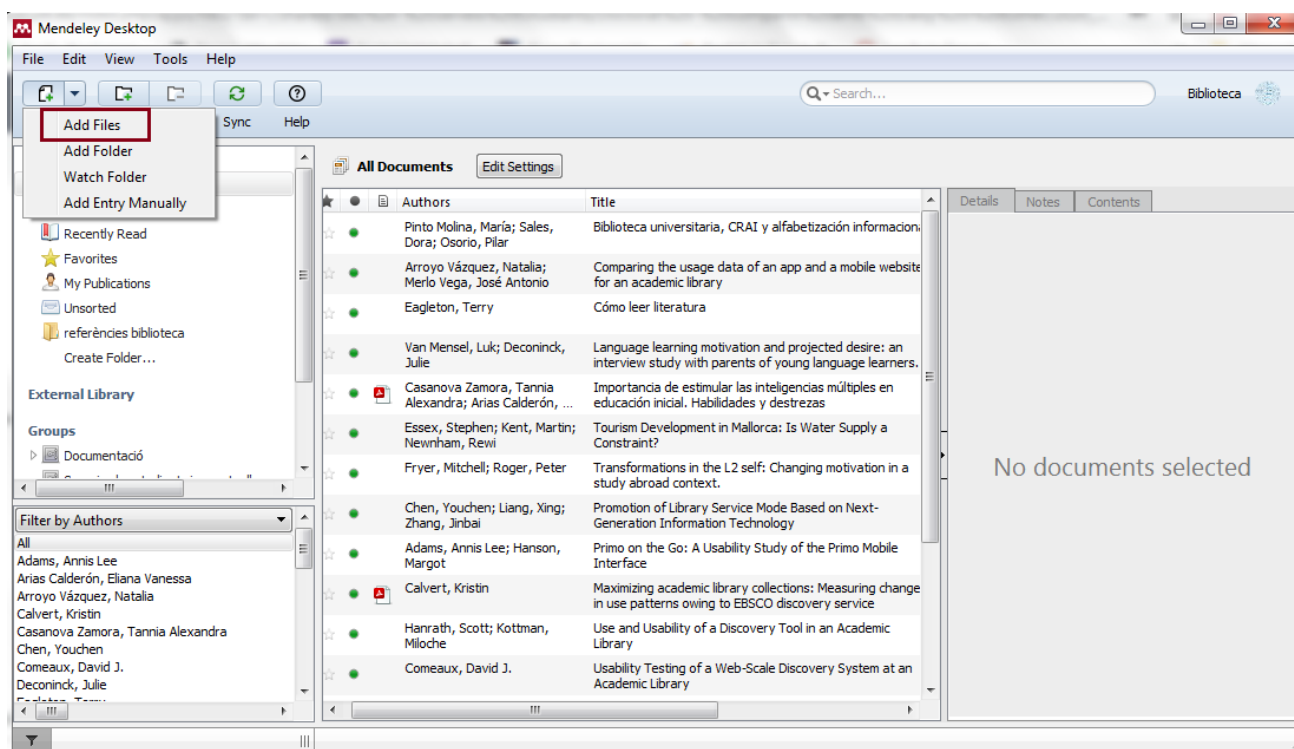

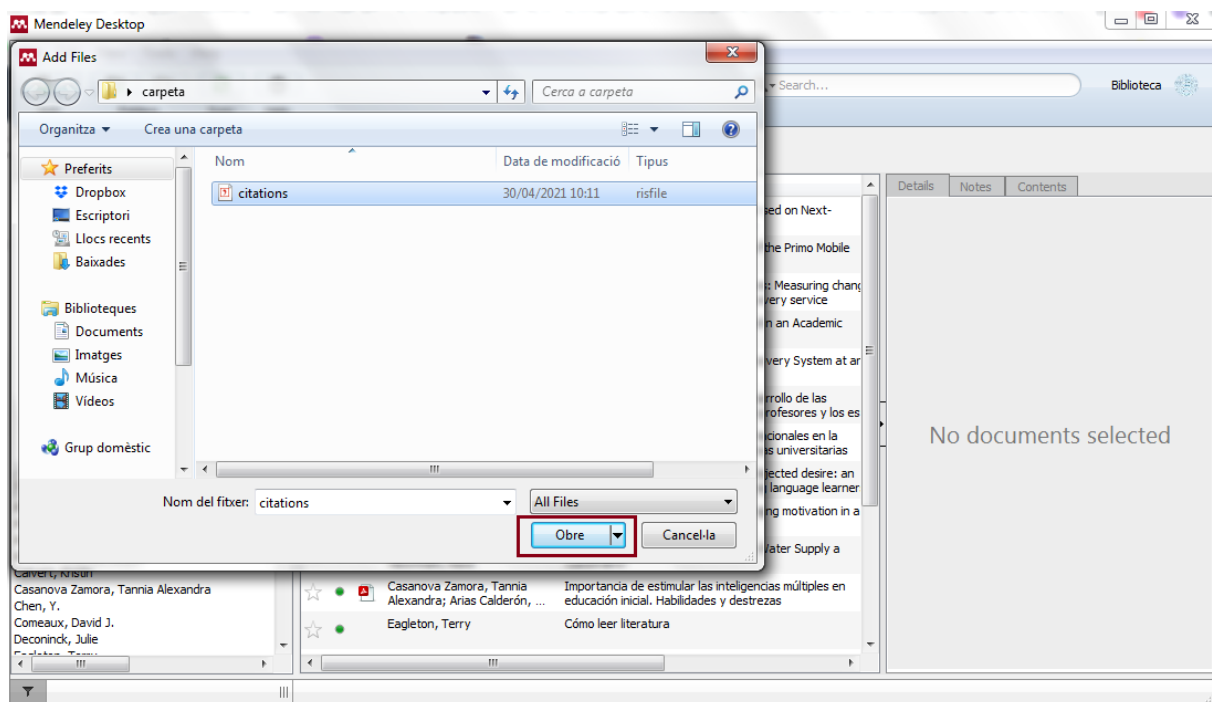
Encara que *Web Importer* funciona per a l'exportació des de JSTOR, la manera més eficaç d'exportar referències a Mendeley és a través d'un arxiu .RIS. Selecciona els resultats de la cerca que vols exportar i al desplegable *Export Selected Citations* escull l'opció *Export a RIS file*:
