

What is the inter-library loan service?

If you need to write an assignment or do research on a topic and require an article or book not available at the UIB library, there's no need to worry—we can request it from another university.

The University of the Balearic Islands offers an Inter-Library Loan Service aimed at:

- Researchers
- Members of the academic community, i.e. students, teaching and research staff (PDI), or admin and services staff (PAS)
- External members or institutions.

Although the service is not free-of-charge, the UIB covers all expenses for members of the academic community.

Below is a list of the different types of documents you can request:

- Hard copies of books
- Book chapters
- Journal articles
- Theses and dissertations
- Excerpts from old books and documents.
